BAG & BUNDLE

LCP (Letter Carrier Presort) files have been sorted to Canada Post Presort Standards using computer software. The computer software has assigned a Bag Number and a Bundle Number along with Break Marks (Asterisks) to each record or Label. The numbers appear as:

121/03 = Bag#/Bun#.

The Asterisks appearing occasionally after the Bundle Numbers are Breaks. One asterisk starts a new Bundle and two asterisks starts a new Bag. It is important that these markings are transferred to the mail piece in the above sample locations. Failure to print these markings on the mail piece will result in higher sortation costs.
